HOMEWORK CONTRACT

Homework is required to be completed by each student as it is assigned. The completion of homework assists me in making sure that the skill was understood by the student. The following information will help you understand the consequences of incomplete homework that will be implemented in our classroom.

- 1. Each assignment is due at the required time.
- 2. A grace period of 1 day will be given for missing/late assignment. TEN POINTS will be deducted from the final grade. If the student fails to turn in the assignment the following day, he/she will receive an automatic zero. (See example below.)

 ***Math assignment is due on Tuesday. Billy did not get it done.
 Billy turns in the assignment on Wednesday. He would have earned a 90 if he had turned in the assignment on time. Since it was a day late, Billy received an 80. If Billy had chosen not to turn in the assignment, he would receive a zero.***
- 3. The student will receive a recess detention for each late assignment. Once a total of 3 homework detentions have been given, he/she will automatically receive an after school detention.

CONSEQUENCES

For each consequence, the following will apply:

1st, 2nd or 3rd consequence = loss of a ticket(s) and afternoon recess detention

(A pink note will be sent home to notify you of the missing assignment. Please sign the pink slip and return it to school with your child.)

4th consequence = lunch detention & parent contact

NO HOMEWORK or INCOMPLETE ASSIGNMENT will result in loss of a ticket and automatic afternoon recess detention.

Please remember that 3 recess detentions equal 1 lunch detention.
